

## DOWNLOADING TO A NOOK

Make sure that Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) is downloaded to your computer to sync with the Nook. Make sure your Nook is authorized under the same ADE id (email address) as the computer. (You can download ADE free from the sidebar at <http://dbooks/wplc.info> - just scroll down to the bottom of the page).

Library-owned computers cannot have the ADE downloaded onto them. However, you can look up, put on hold and checkout eBooks on library computers. The downloading and transferring must be done using your personal computer.

1. Find an e-Book title at <http://dbooks/wplc.info> and check it out.
2. Click the **Download** button
3. Click **Open**—Your title should automatically open in Adobe Digital Editions.
4. Connect the Nook to your PC with your USB cord.
5. ADE should recognize the Nook as a device. (Lower left sidebar).
6. Go back to '**borrowed**' in ADE and drag the downloaded book to the word Nook on the left screen. You can now see the book in the Nook.
  - a. NOTE – For some devices, titles end up in the Nook's Digital Editions (DE) folder. If you disconnect the nook and try to read it, you will not see it in your library listings on the Nook.
    - i. While connected to the PC, you must go to My Computer, find the Nook, and go to its DE folder. Leave the PDF or EPUB file in that folder, but you must copy it and paste it to the Nook's My Documents folder.
    - ii. If you copy to My Documents but don't also leave it in the DE folder, you can see the book on the Nook but you get an authorized read error and you can't access.
7. Close ADE software and disconnect your Nook from your computer.
8. On the Nook, click **My Library**.
9. Then click **View My Documents**. It will refresh and the Overdrive title appears. Now you can read the book.
