

Check Out a Public Library Book for Kindle

You can borrow Kindle books from your local library's website, and, with the click of a button, have them delivered to your Kindle device or free reading app.

Instructions:

1. Visit Oregon Public Library's homepage, www.oregonpubliclibrary.org.
2. Click on "Digital Books & Audio" on the left side of the page.
3. Check out a Kindle book. Our library system is South Central Library System. Enter your complete barcode number.
4. If the title is available, click on "Get for Kindle." You will then be directed to Amazon.com to redeem your public library loan. You may be required to login to your Amazon.com account -- or create a new account -- if you're not already logged in. (Your credit card will not be charged when downloading
5. If the title is not available, click on "Add to cart."
6. Choose to read the book on your Kindle device, free reading app, or Kindle Cloud Reader.
7. Your content will be available the next time you sync your device.

Note: Public library books require an active Wi-Fi connection for wireless delivery to a Kindle device. Library books will not be delivered via your Kindle's 3G connection. If trying to send to a Kindle device and do not have an active Wi-Fi connection, you may instead choose to load your library book via USB. Both Mac and Windows users can manage Kindle content through a USB connection. (Detailed instructions can be found on Amazon's website.)

Yes. You can browse, check out, and download Kindle eBooks from your library using your Kindle Fire - you don't need to use a computer. Note that you cannot install the OverDrive Media Console app on your Kindle.

Deleting a title after expired or returning early:

1. Go to amazon.com
2. Your Account dropdown—select Manage your Kindle
3. Sign in to your account
4. View dropdown menu—select Loans
5. Actions dropdown (far right of page) within the title you want to delete
6. Select Return this book
7. Your book will be in the archive/ cloud area. You will need to check the title out again from the library to read it again. It should remember any bookmarks or notes.
