For beginners, ages 9- adult (for ages 9-12 please bring an adult helper).

Registration required.

Had enough winter??? Start planning for summer picnics or pot lucks by sewing a carrier for your pie, 9x9" or 9x13" baking dish.

Attendees will provide their own fabric, plus a small ruler, scissors, pins, or clips.



Bring the fabrics of your choosing according to the chart below, or bring enough "strips" to sew your own unique fabric.

	pie plate or 9x9"	9x13"
Outer fabric	2 - 18x18" pieces of fabric, the same print or coordinating	2 - 22x22" pieces of fabric, the same print or coordinating
loops & holder	2 - 3x7" and 1 - 5x18" (use any coordinating fabric)	2 - 3x7" and 1 - 5x22" (use any coordinating fabric)

If you bring your sewing machine, bring thread & a filled bobbin. (It's always a good idea to bring your sewing machine manual, just in case!)

The library will provide-

- Instruction
- Stabilizer & batting
- Irons & ironing boards
- Rotary cutter & mat
