

Activities:

You can do an activity multiple times. The activities are under the Badge name in Beanstack.

Read

- Read a non-fiction book about an animal.
- Read a book with a rhyme.
- Make a snack together by following a recipe.
- Talk about how to hold a book and the parts of it.
- Write a story about what you did that day and read it back to your child.

Play

- Make a blanket fort and play inside.
- Play peek-a-boo or hide and seek.
- Play with bubbles! Make your own bubbles.
- Stack plastic cups.
- Make rainbow pasta. Great sensory activity.
- Pretend you are your favorite animal.
- Play a color sorting game.
- Play at a park that is new to you.
- Sort objects into muffin tin cups!

Sing

- Clap your hands or stomp your feet while you sing.
- Sing a song super fast, then super slow.
- Find something to use as a shaker and shake along with the music.
- Take a song you know and change the words to something silly. Include your child's name.

Talk

- At bedtime, talk about what you did that day.
- Talk about the first letter of your child's name and find other words that start with that letter.
- Point out words on signs.
- Use a stuffed animal to "talk" to child.
- Have child use toys to retell a story.
- Ask questions about what child sees outside.
- Talk about your feelings.

Write

- Use a paint brush and water to "paint" on the sidewalk.
- Draw a picture for a neighbor with sidewalk chalk.
- Have your child write their name on their artwork.
- Play with ABC blocks, puzzles, or fridge magnets.
- Have child help write a grocery list.

1. Register online on Oregon Public Library's Beanstack by scanning the QR code or at oregonpubliclibrary.beanstack.org/reader365
2. The Read to Me Program is for ages 0-4
3. This sheet is to help with tracking.
4. Anytime you or others read to your child it counts as reading!
5. You can swap out reading for activities listed on this log.
6. Each circle on this log equals one picture book read or one activity completed.
7. After you read or do an activity, mark off a circle.
8. The Librarians are here to help! Please ask!
