How the Teen program works:

- 1. Keep track of how many minutes you read. Reading books, graphic novels, comic books, non-fiction, magazines, and audiobooks all count!
- 2. When you read for **30 minutes**, fill in 1 circle on the paint palette on the back of this sheet.
- 3. You can choose to do an activity instead of reading. The activities are listed at the bottom of this sheet. You can do them in any order. When you complete an activity, you can fill in 1 circle.
- 4. Come to the Oregon Public Library to collect your prizes. Prizes are earned once you fill in the three circles that come before the prize (every 90 mins).

• Attend a library program for teens.


