### **Attendees will provide-**

- Several coordinating fat quarters for the outside & lining of the bag (holiday fabric, juvenile prints for kids gift bags, or anything you'd like)
- Thread that coordinates with the outer fabric (lines of stitching will be visible on outside of bag)
- Scissors that will cut fabric, pins, seam ripper
- If you bring your sewing machine- bring thread & a filled bobbin. (It's always a good idea to bring your sewing machine manual, just in case!)

### **The library will provide-**

- Instruction
- Various colors and widths of ribbon
- Irons & ironing boards
- Rotary cutter & mat
