## Sew What: Zipper Pouch

When: Thursday, January 5, 2017 at 6pm (doors open at 5:45pm)

For beginners, ages 9- adult (for ages 9-12 please bring an adult helper)

Skills you'll learn: how to insert a zipper

### How should you prepare?

1. Have your fabric cut & ironed. You'll need 2- 10x7" pieces for the outside of the pouch, and 2- 10x7" pieces for the lining.
2. We will have lots of 9" zippers – or bring one that coordinates with your outer fabric
3. Bring thread that coordinates with your outer fabric
4. Scissors that will cut fabric, pins, seam ripper
5. If you bring your sewing machine- bring thread & a filled bobbin, and **Zipper Foot**. (It's always a good idea to bring your sewing machine manual, just in case!)

### The library will provide-

- Irons & ironing boards
- Assorted spools of thread & zippers
- If you use our machines, we will provide thread & bobbins
