

# Sew What?!

## Pot Luck Bowl Cover – May 4, 2017

### Supplies:

3/8" elastic  
Fabric  
Fusible fleece  
Thread to match

### Prepare fabric

- Measure diameter of bowl, add 3" to that number. The result is the diameter of the circle you will cut, both from the outside & lining fabrics.
- Cut 2 fabrics & 1 fusible fleece this size.

### Cover construction

- Fuse fleece to lining fabric.
- Using 1/2" seam allowance, pin and sew around the edge, leaving a 5" opening. Trim to 1/4" seam allowance and clip to allow for a smooth finish. \*Do not trim the 5" left for the opening.
- Turn right sides out. Press.
- Pin around the edge to hold the fabric steady- sew around circumference with exactly 1/2" seam allowance. Leave 5" opening as is.
- Measure circumference of bowl, cut elastic 2" less that length. Attach safety pin to one end, and feed elastic through the channel. Then sew 2 edges of elastic together with a 1" overlap, securing with zigzag stitches.
- Tuck in raw edges of the 5" opening. Whip stitch with needle & thread.

### Optional

- Custom cut- size will depend upon utensils. Add fabric piece to hold serving utensils.
