

## 2019 Sew What: Storage Pods

Can you picture these cute little storage pods in pastel spring prints? Or maybe brights to match the décor in the kids' room? They're large enough to hold small skeins of yarn, markers, notepads, or other small items. Finished size is 5 ½ x 9 ½ x 5".

Set up starts at 9am

For beginners, ages 9 to adult (kids ages 9-12 MUST have an adult stay to help them)

Skills you'll learn: how to apply fusible batting; good topstitching techniques

### Supplies you need to bring to make ONE pod ---

1. FABRIC - 2 coordinating fat quarters for each storage pod (or fabric to measure 18x21")
2. THREAD to match your fabric (for construction of pods, and topstitching); 2 bobbins
3. ESSENTIAL SUPPLIES you need to bring-
  - Scissors for cutting fabric
  - Pins
  - Seam ripper
  - A hand sewing needle
4. If you bring your sewing machine- check to make sure it's in working order, and bring your instruction manual

### The library will provide -

- Fusible batting
- Patterns for the project
- Irons & ironing boards
- Extra sewing machines
