

# Water Bottle Holder

Do you carry a water bottle but are tired of lugging it around? Our September Sew What event will teach you how to make this useful holder.

## **For Adults and Older Teens:**

This project is for those at an intermediate sewing level, not beginners.

**Skills you'll learn:** how to apply eyelets (grommets), how to sew curves, how to work with nylon webbing and bungee cord.

The library will supply the fabric & all notions (bungee cord, webbing, toggle spring stop, eyelets).

## **You need to bring:**

1. Your water bottle (we'll need to measure it to construct the pattern)
2. White thread
3. Basic sewing supplies-
  - Scissors for cutting fabric
  - Pins
  - Seam ripper
  - A hand sewing needle
  - Tape measure
4. If you bring your sewing machine- check to make sure it's in working order, and bring your instruction manual
